

## JUNIOR SOLO PIANOFORTE

### 12.01 Patricia Read Memorial Cup

For repertoire. Age 14 to under 17 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup & Gold Medal. Also €100 *presented anonymously.*

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal & €50 *presented anonymously.*

**Entrance:** €50

#### **Test:**

Competitors to perform a programme of their own choice not exceeding 15 minutes' duration. Movements & Opus nos. must be specified on entry form.

**NB:** *From 2018, previous winners of the Rhona Marshall Cup are permitted to enter the Patricia Read Memorial Cup, even if under 14 years. Upper age limit of 17 still applies.*

### 12.02 Dorothy Stokes Cup

*Presented by her pupils and friends.* For Junior Sonata playing.

Age 14 to under 17 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup. Also a medallion which will become the property of the winner.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

#### **Test:**

One movement from a sonata of own choice (excluding Baroque sonatas). Movement must be specified on entry form.

### 12.03 Claude Biggs Memorial Cup

*Presented by Michael & Frances Biggs.*

For performers under 17 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

#### **Test:**

(a) Bach: Any one of the Three-Part Inventions (also known as Sinfonias)

(b) Scarlatti: Any one Sonata (without repeats)

### 12.04 Junior Concerto

For Junior Pianoforte Concerto. Age 12 to under 17 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Gold Medal

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €50

#### **Test:**

One movement from a concerto of own choice. Movement & Opus no. must be specified on entry form.

The orchestral part to be played on a second piano. Pianist must be provided by the competitor.

### 12.05 Rhona Marshall Cup

*Presented by her friends & pupils. Monetary awards presented by the Rhona Marshall Trust.*

For repertoire. Age 11 to under 14 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup, Gold Medal and €100.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal and €50.  
**Entrance:** €40

**Test:**

Competitors to perform a programme of own choice not exceeding 12 minutes maximum. Movements & Opus nos. to be specified on entry form.

**12.06 John Field Cup**

Cup presented by Neasa Nic Fhionnlaoich. Monetary awards presented by Dr. John O'Conor. Under 15 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup, Gold Medal & €150  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal & €50  
**Entrance:** €40

**Test:**

Any Nocturne by John Field except No. 18 in E 'Le Midi'. Key must be stated on entry form.

**12.07 Junior Pianoforte Solo (A)**

The Isabel Bryan Spratt Memorial Cup, presented by the late Miss Sheelah Spratt. Performers under 17 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal  
**Entrance:** €40

**Test:**

- (a) Liszt: Consolation No. 3 in D flat Major ( S.172)
- (b) Bartók: Suite Op. 14, 1st movt.

*NB: Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

**12.08 Junior Pianoforte Solo (B)**

The Alice Carty Trophy, presented in her memory by her daughter Jane. Performers under 15 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Trophy & Gold Medal  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal  
**Entrance:** €40

**Test:**

- (a) Haydn: Sonata in A flat Major, Hob XVI/46, last movt. (without repeats)
- (b) Debussy: La fille aux cheveux de lin. Preludes Book 1, No. 8

*NB: Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

**12.09 Junior Pianoforte Solo (C)**

The Joseph McDonagh Cup, presented in his memory by his daughter Kate. Performers under 13 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal.  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal.  
**Entrance:** €40

**Test:**

- (a) Grieg: Puck (Småtroll) Lyric Pieces Op. 71 No. 3 (without repeats)
- (b) Mendelssohn: Song Without Words, Op. 38 No. 2 in c minor

(b) Schumann: First Loss, Op. 68 No. 16 from 'Album for the Young' (without repeat)

### **12.11 Junior Pianoforte Solo (E)**

The Alice Bryan Cup. *Presented in her memory by Marie Jones.*

Performers under 9 years.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Gold Medal

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €30

**Test:**

(a) Beethoven: Russian Folk Song, Op. 107 No. 3

Classics to Moderns Book 1

(b) Kabalevsky: Waltz, Op. 39 No. 13

24 Pieces for Children
