17.01 Junior French Horn (A)

Performers under 17 years.

1st Prize: Gold Medal
2nd Prize: Silver Medal
Entrance: €40

Test:

- (a) **Mozart** Concerto No. 1, 2nd movt, Rondo
- (b) **Guy Woolfenden** Lotus Waltz, from *Horn Dances* (Brass/Wind)

Official accompanist must be used.

17.02 Junior French Horn (B)

Performers under 14 years.

1st Prize: Gold Medal
2nd Prize: Silver Medal
Entrance: €40

Test:

- (a) Three and Easy, from *Big Chillers* (Brass/Wind)
- (b) Ragtime Horn, from *Ten Easy Tunes* (Fentone Music)

Official accompanist must be used.

17.03 Junior Trumpet/Cornet (A)

Performers under 17 years.

1st Prize: Gold Medal
2nd Prize: Silver Medal
Entrance: €40

Test:

- (a) Gagaku
- (b) Tango Argentino
Both from *A tango to Bali* by Adam Gorb (Brass/wind)

Official accompanist must be used.

17.04 Junior Trumpet/Cornet (B)

Performers under 14 years.

Entrance: €40

Test:

- (a) Moment Musical
- (b) Boogie on Down
Both from *Rhythm and Rags* by Alan Haughton (ABRSM)

Official accompanist must be used.

17.06 Junior Brass Instrumental

Performers under 17 years.

Open to trombone, tuba, bass & euphonium/baritone.

1st Prize: Gold Medal

2nd Prize: Silver Medal

Entrance: €40

Test:

Tuba

Alexander Tcherpnin Andante

Euphonium

Air and Variations - No.4 from 'Super Solos' by Philip Sparke

Trombone

Arr: Christopher Mowat Polonaise and March 'Bach for Trombone' (Brass/Wind)

Official accompanist must be used.

17.11 Junior Brass Ensemble Cup

Cup, *presented by Mr. W.G. Miller.* Open to a minimum of 3 and maximum of 8 brass instruments. Conductor not allowed.

Performers under 18 years.

Prize: Cup

Entrance: €50

Test:

A programme of own choice, not to exceed 10 minutes. A considerable proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of the piece(s) chosen.
