### 5.02 Open Orchestra

Open to regional, local or community orchestras and orchestras based in schools of music. Minimum players: 15. The following instruments are essential - first violins, second violins, third violins or violas, cellos. All other orchestral instruments are optional.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup and certificate

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Certificate

**Entrance:** €70

#### **Test:**

Contrasting pieces of own choice. Playing time not to exceed 15 minutes.

A proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of pieces selected

**NB:** Competitors may not play in more than one orchestra.

### 5.03 Primary School Orchestra

The Peter Killian Cup, *presented by the Post-Primary Music Teachers Association.*

Confined to schools.

**NB:** Orchestra members must be registered students of the school represented.

Minimum players: 15.

The following instruments are essential - first violins, second violins, third violins or violas, cellos. All other orchestral instruments are optional.

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** Cup and certificate to conductor

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** Certificate

**Entrance:** €70

#### **Test:**

Contrasting pieces of own choice. Playing time not to exceed 15 minutes.

A proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of pieces selected.

### 5.04 Post-Primary School Orchestra

The Dorothy Mayer Foundation Cup, *presented by Ceol Chumann na nÓg.*

**NB:** Competitors must be registered students of the school represented.

Minimum players: 15.
