

## Junior Solo Pianoforte

### 12.01 PATRICIA READ MEMORIAL CUP

For repertoire. Age 14 to under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal. Also €100 *presented anonymously*.

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal and €50 *presented anonymously*.

**Entrance:** €50

**Test:** Competitors to perform a programme of own choice not exceeding 15 minutes' duration. Movements & opus nos. must be specified on entry form.

***Previous winners of the Rhona Marshall Cup are permitted to enter the Patricia Read Memorial Cup, even if under 14 years. Upper age limit of 17 still applies.***

### 12.02 DOROTHY STOKES CUP

*Presented by her pupils and friends.* For junior sonata playing.

Age 14 to under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and the Dorothy Stokes Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** One movement from a sonata of own choice (excluding Baroque sonatas). Movement must be specified on entry form.

### 12.03 CLAUD BIGGS MEMORIAL CUP

*Presented by Michael & Frances Biggs.*

Performers under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) J S Bach: **Any Allemande or Courante from the Partitas** (repeats allowed)  
(b) Scarlatti: **Any Sonata** (without repeats)

### 12.04 JUNIOR CONCERTO

For junior pianoforte concerto. Age 12 to under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €50

**Test:** One movement from a concerto of own choice. Movement & opus no. must be specified on entry form.

The orchestral part to be played on a second piano. Pianist must be provided by the competitor.

### 12.05 RHONA MARSHALL CUP

*Presented by her friends & pupils. Monetary awards presented by the Rhona Marshall Trust.*

For repertoire. Age 11 to under 14 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup, Gold Medal and €100

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal and €50

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** Competitors to perform a programme of own choice not exceeding 12 minutes maximum. Movements & opus nos. to be specified on entry form.

### 12.06 JOHN FIELD CUP

*Cup presented by Neasa Nic Fhionnlaoich. Monetary awards presented by Dr. John O'Connor. Performers under 15 years.*

**1st Prize:** Cup, Gold Medal and €150

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal and €50

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** Any Nocturne by John Field except No. 18 in E 'Le Midi'. Key must be stated on entry form.

### 12.07 JUNIOR PIANOFORTE SOLO (A)

*The Isabel Bryan Spratt Memorial Cup, presented by the late Miss Sheelah Spratt.*

Performers under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) Haydn: **Sonata in b minor XVI/32, 3rd movt.** (no repeats)  
(b) Sibelius: **Romance in D flat, Op. 24 No. 9**

*NB: Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

### 12.08 JUNIOR PIANOFORTE SOLO (B)

*The Alice Carty Trophy, presented in her memory by her daughter Jane.*

Performers under 15 years.

**1st Prize:** Trophy and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) Mozart: **Fantasy in d minor K 397** (no repeats)  
(b) Bartók: **No 6 from Six Dances in Bulgarian Rhythm**, Mikrokosmos Book 6

*NB: Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

### 12.09 JUNIOR PIANOFORTE SOLO (C)

The Joseph McDonagh Cup, *presented in his memory by his daughter Kate.*

Performers under 13 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) Shostakovich: **Prelude in E flat Op. 34 No 19**  
(b) Clementi: **Sonatina in F, Op. 36 No. 4, last movement** (with Da Capo)  
(ABRSM, Peters, or Henle editions)

***NB:** Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

A foot rest (without pedal extenders) will be made available for young piano competitors, should they wish to avail of it. However, if a competitor has been practising with a pedal extender, they may use it in competition, but must provide their own.

### 12.10 JUNIOR PIANOFORTE SOLO (D)

Performers under 11 years.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €30

**Test:** (a) Burgmüller: **Innocence**  
No. 5 from 25 Études faciles et Progressives Op. 100  
(b) J S Bach: **Little Prelude in F BWV 927**  
No. 3 from the Klavierbüchlein für W Fr Bach

***NB:** Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*

**Test:** (a) Gretchaninoff: **Farewell, Op. 98 No. 4**  
(b) Gretchaninoff: **On Horseback, Op. 98 No. 5**

***NB:** Recalls, at the discretion of the adjudicator, may be held.*
