

## Senior Brass

### 16.01 SENIOR BRASS RECITAL

**Age Limit:** 17 – 24 years.

**Prize:** Gold Medal. **The winner will also be awarded a bursary to attend Dublin Brass Week 2020**

**Entrance:** €60

**Test:** A recital of not more than 15 minutes' duration of the competitor's own choice. Individual movements acceptable.

A proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of the programme.

Competitors must provide their own accompanist.

If a competitor has entered the Walton Cup for Senior Brass Instrumental Playing in 2020, the piece(s) performed may not be repeated.

*Previous winners are not eligible.*

**PLEASE NOTE** that the winner of this competition is eligible to apply for the RDS €15,000 Music Bursary.

### 16.02 THE WALTON CUP

Cup, *presented by Waltons Ltd.* For senior brass instrumental playing. Open to French horn, trumpet/cornet, trombone, tuba/bass & euphonium/baritone.

**1st Prize:** Cup and Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €50

**Test:** Own choice – programme not to exceed 12 minutes.

Competitors must provide their own accompanist.

### 16.09 THE ANCHOR CUP

Perpetual Cup, *presented by St George's Brass Band and the 55th Old Boys' Brass Band Belfast.* For ensemble of brass instruments (min. 3, max. 8). Conductor not allowed.

**Prize:** Cup

**Entrance:** €60

**Test:** A programme of own choice, not to exceed 12 minutes

A considerable proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of the piece(s) chosen.

*Time Pieces for Horn Volume 2 (ABRSM)*

*Official accompanist must be used.*

### 17.02 JUNIOR FRENCH HORN (B)

Performers under 14 years.

**1st Prize:** Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) Lizzie Davis: **En Cor Hornet's Nest** (Brass/Wind)  
(b) Richard Bissill: **David of the White Rock Going Solo Horn** (Brass/Wind)

### 17.03 JUNIOR TRUMPET/CORNET (A)

Performers under 17 years.

**1st Prize:** Gold Medal      **2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** Eugène Bozza: **Badinage** (Alphonse Leduc)

*Official accompanist must be used.*

### 17.04 JUNIOR TRUMPET/CORNET (B)

Performers under 14 years.

**1st Prize:** Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** (a) Anon- **Bugle Horn**  
(b) Thomas Erskine: **Largo** (ABRSM -Time Pieces for Trumpet Volume 3)

*Official accompanist must be used.*

## 17.06 JUNIOR BRASS INSTRUMENTAL

Performers under 17 years.

Open to trombone, tuba, bass & euphonium/baritone.

**1st Prize:** Gold Medal

**2nd Prize:** Silver Medal

**Entrance:** €40

**Test:** ***Trombone:***

Jim Parker: **Trinidad**, from 'Jazzed Up Too' (Brass Wind 1119)

***Euphonium:***

Keith Amos: **No. 1 Quixotic** and **No. 2 Quietude**, from 'Lucian's Humours for Euphonium' (CMA Publs. 281)

***Tuba:***

Gordon Jacob: **No. 2 Marching Tune** and **No. 6 Scottish**, from 'Six Little Pieces' (Emerson)

*Official accompanist must be used.*

## 17.11 JUNIOR BRASS ENSEMBLE CUP

Cup, *presented by Mr. W.G. Miller*. Open to a minimum of 3 and maximum of 8 brass instruments. Conductor not allowed.

Performers under 18 years.

**Prize:** Cup

**Entrance:** €50

**Test:** A programme of own choice, not to exceed 10 minutes. A considerable proportion of the marks will be given for the musical value of the piece(s) chosen.
