Viola, double bass, harp and guitar – 12 to under 18.

1st Prize: Cup and Gold Medal

2nd Prize: Silver Medal

Entrance: €50

Test: In preliminary round, a programme of short pieces of own choice.
Eight finalists will be chosen to perform in the final round on a different day during Feis Ceoil.
Please note that **both** the preliminary and final rounds will have a programme duration of **12 minutes**.
Competitors must provide their own accompanist

1st Prize: Trophy, Gold Medal and €250

2nd Prize: Silver Medal

Entrance: €50

Test: One movement from a concerto of own choice. Movement must be specified on entry form.

Orchestral Part to be played on piano. Pianist must be provided by the competitor.
