

JUNIOR VOCAL

4.01 THE KITTY O'CALLAGHAN TROPHY

Presented by her friends in her honour. For junior voice and pianoforte.

Age Limits: 14 to under 19 years for both singer and accompanist. Both names to be stated on the entry form.

1st Prize: Silver Salvers and Gold Medals

2nd Prize: Silver Medals

Entrance: €40

Test: Two contrasting songs of own choice. A proportion of marks will be awarded for the quality and suitability of the choice of programme. The competition will be judged as an equal partnership of vocalist and accompanist (i.e. marks will be awarded for the accompanist as well as the vocalist).

NB: Please ensure that all own choice pieces are submitted at time of entry, ***as no change of repertoire will be allowed after competition entry deadline.***

4.02 JUNIOR VOCAL RECITAL

Cup presented by the late Mr Maurice Flynn. Also the Sr. Peter Cronin €500 Award, presented by Virginia Kerr in her memory.

Age Limit: 15 to under 19 years.

1st Prize: Cup, Gold Medal and €500

2nd Prize: Silver Medal

Entrance: €50

Test: Competitors to perform 3 songs of contrasting character, not to exceed 10 minutes. Programme to be listed on entry form.

Competitors must provide their own accompanist. **NB:** Please ensure that all own choice pieces are submitted at time of entry, ***as no change of repertoire will be allowed after competition entry deadline.***

4.03 PAUL DEEGAN CUP

Presented by the late Paul Deegan. Open to male voices only. Performers under 19 years.

Piano accompaniment only. Costume optional.

Competitors must use the official accompanist provided.

Please note: A proportion of the marks will be awarded for acting through song and appropriateness of repertoire to voice type and stage of vocal development.

Please ensure the name of your chosen piece is submitted at time of entry, ***as no change of repertoire will be allowed after competition entry deadline.***
